The 21st Century Learning Institute is a weeklong residential program. Participants attend performances, discussions, and hands-on workshops that enable them to explore the various roles of dance, music, theatre, and visual arts in teaching and learning.

The dance, music, theatre, and visual arts are all explored as separate content areas as well as integrated with other content areas.

Relationships among the arts disciplines are examined including ways they affect children's motivation, learning, comprehension, development of critical thinking, and mastery of problem solving skills.

Program Outcomes: Participants will...

- Design and implement an integrated, arts centered educational program that creates an exciting and dynamic environment for learning.
- Design performance assessment strategies that measure student achievement in the arts and other disciplines.

Program Schedule:

The week begins with registration and introductions on Sunday afternoon. During the week participants will experience hands-on workshops taught by professional teaching artists who are exemplary in their field and highly experienced in arts integrated teaching. Evening events will include a tour of historic Annapolis and professional performances at Maryland hall for the Performing Arts. The week will culminate on Friday when participants will have the opportunity to express what they saw, learned, and what they dream to do with their new knowledge.

Program Details:

- **The program cost is \$1800/per participant. This amount includes room and board, ground transportation to scheduled events off campus, workshop materials and supplies, and professional artists/ensemble performances.**
- **A DEPOSIT OF \$500 is due with your application form – Deadline for application and deposit is FRIDAY, MAY 8th!**
- **Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Register early to assure your spot! Space is limited.**
