ARTS IN EDUCATION GRANTS - MARYLAND STATE ARTS COUNCIL

AiE Grants are available to support arts learning activities in Maryland schools by providing funding for MSAC Roster teaching artists to host residencies, support arts integration in non-arts subjects and after school programs.

- Teaching artist must be on the [MSAC Teaching Artist Roster](#)
- Maximum \$6,000 per grant
- Rolling deadline; maximum 2 grants within one fiscal year (July 1-June 1)
- Private schools with 501(c)3 status and public schools are eligible
